We pride ourselves on having no barrier to entry. In collaboration with our sister Formula SAE and Supermileage teams, we help offer a vast collection of training programs and classes, geared towards design and manufacturing in a fast-paced automotive environment. We do not charge any membership fees.





New members are provided with the foundational skills required to succeed not only in Baja, but as a professional engineer as they continue to advance their career. *In 2022 alone, Bruin Racing trained:*

- 187 students in CAD (SOLIDWORKS)
- 141 students in machining
- 24 students in circuit design and construction
- 18 students in composites manufacturing

AMBITION

In Baja, all teams are provided with the same engine and rules, but there are few other restraints on creativity. **Innovation** characterizes the highest-achieving teams. We take this to heart, and strive to incorporate ambitious yet achievable features in all of our systems.

Chassis

2023 Achievements:

- Tube bending and notching done in-house for the first time in school history
- Dedicated aerodynamics research team

2024 Goals:

- Iterative, noise-reduced data acquisition to validate FEA simulations
- Reduce weight through shorter chassis

Transmission

2023 Achievements:

- Custom electromechanically-actuated continuously variable transmission
- Active impeller-based cooling system

2024 Goals:

- Maximize efficiency with improved actuator and belt-tensioning system
- Evaluation of optimal engine profile

Powertrain

2023 Achievements:

- Reduced center of gravity with optimized gearbox & centershaft placement
- Improved gear alignment for efficiency

2024 Goals:

- Implementing centerlock system to switch between rear and 4WD
- Reduce overall subsystem weight with improved FEA & validation testing

Suspension

2023 Achievements:

- Eliminated tensile failure on rear J-link tabs
- Increased rear linkage strength with hinge joints

2024 Goals:

- Implement long stroke coilovers to increase clearance and wheel travel
- Increase agility by optimizing suspension geometry

Driver Interface

2023 Achievements:

• Reaserch-based ergonomics for better driver comfort and performance

2024 Goals:

- Reduce steering backlash with higher tolerancing and advanced parts
- Dedicated throttle team to ensure maximum engine output

Electronics

2023 Achievements:

 Custom PCB assembly for driving onboard electronics and transmission

2024 Goals:

- Actuator-based control system to maintain optimal transmission ratio
- Improved data acquisition (DAQ) infrastructure for validation




